Our proposal presents a temporary, semi enclosedenvironment [TempEn] which will act as a multi-polar social atractor: it groups a variety of spaces of different sizes, shapes and heights, able to accommodate a large variety of activities.

Possible uses:

- School gardens
- Lettable spaces
- Open-air cinema
- Sculpture garden
- Playgronds
- Sport fields
- Events spaces

Spatial organisation:

A nominal area of 100 by 75 meters is covered by a 25x25 meters mega grid of 1.5 x 1.5 meter, 4.5 meter high compacted cars columns.
